The main findings of this HPA report are that the UK has long recognised both the importance of, and the health benefits gained from, a clean and healthy environment. A range of initiatives have already led to a significant reduction in child death rates and ill health (mortality and morbidity) across the UK. There are, however, a number of issues highlighted in the report which are important to tackle: new emerging concerns, such as the impact of climate change on children; changing trends, such as the increasing concerns over obesity; and old concerns which continue to have an effect despite improvements and interventions, such as air pollution.
