The scenarios include:-Recovery position and getting help-Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)-Dealing with a suspected heart attack-Dealing with choking-Dealing with serious bleeding.

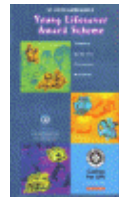
