This game will help to teach the importance of personal hygiene in an entertaining and enjoyable way. It is a game designed for groups of between two and six players aged from five years upwards - plus a group leader - and can be used in a variety of settings. (Suitable for children with special educational needs).



Bag Of Germs
